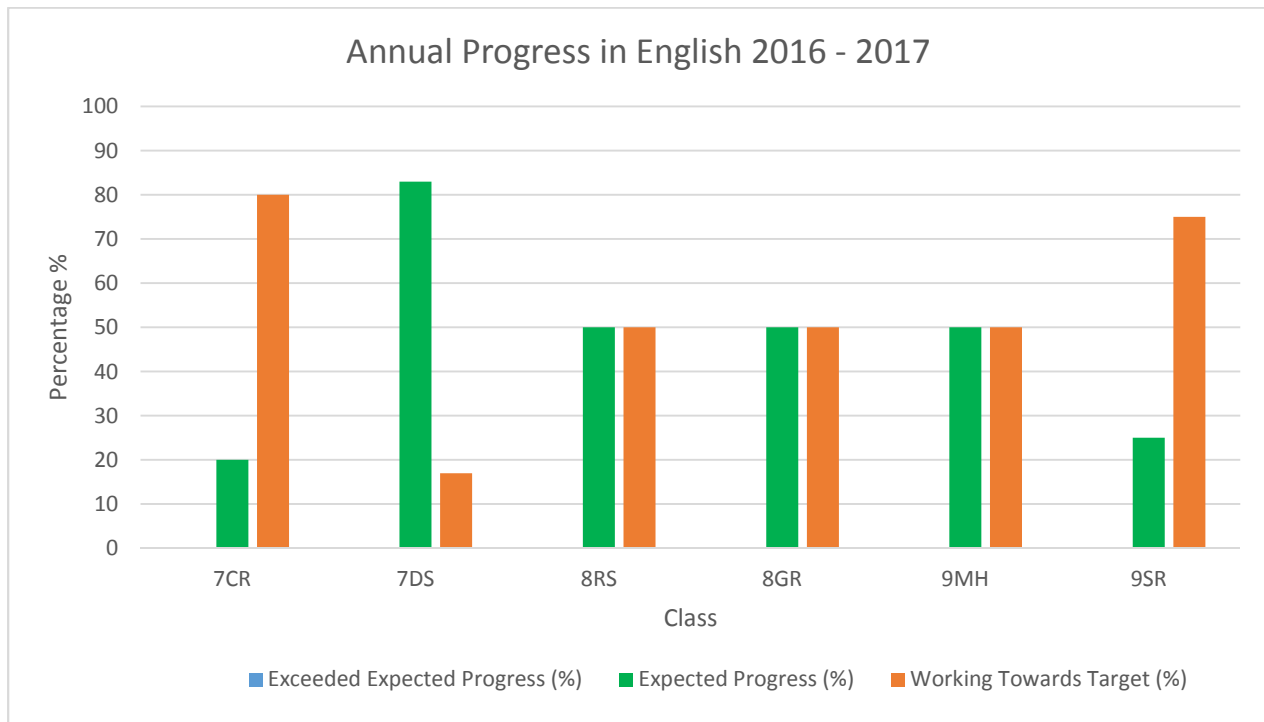


Annual Progress of Key Stage 3 Pupils 2016 – 2017

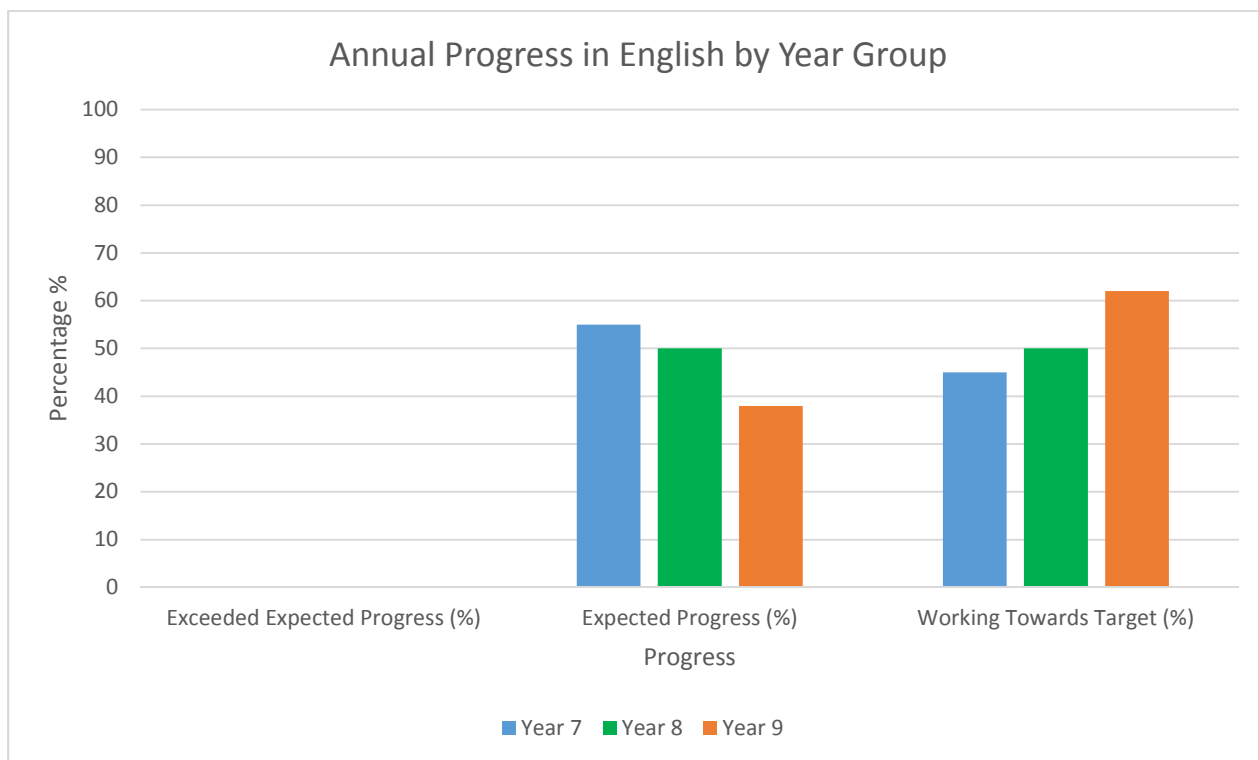
Key Stage 3 English (Years 7, 8 and 9) Progress by Tutor Group



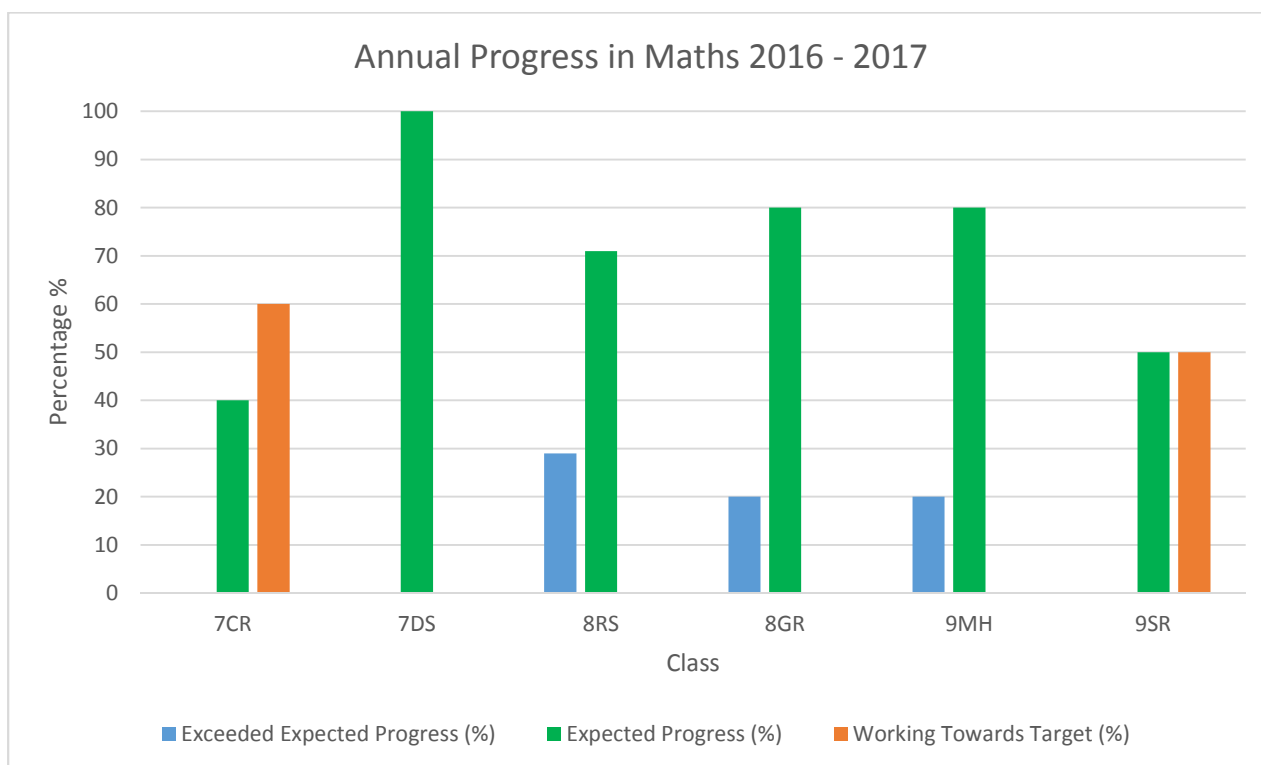
Data Headlines

- In Key Stage3 English, 50% year 8 of pupils made expected progress.

Key Stage 3 English (Years 7, 8 and 9) Progress by Year Group



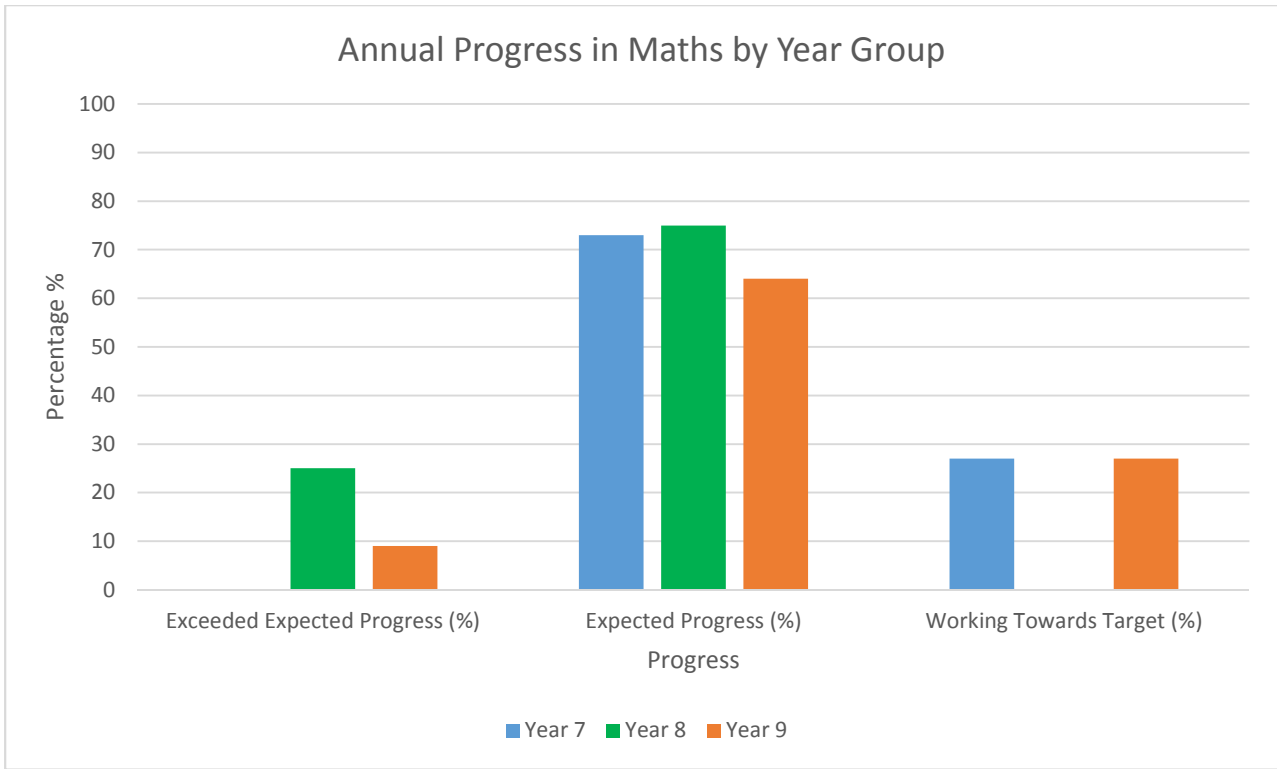
Key Stage 3 Maths (Years 7, 8 and 9) Progress by Tutor Group

- 73% of pupils in year 8 achieved or exceeded their expected progress in Key Stage 3 Maths.

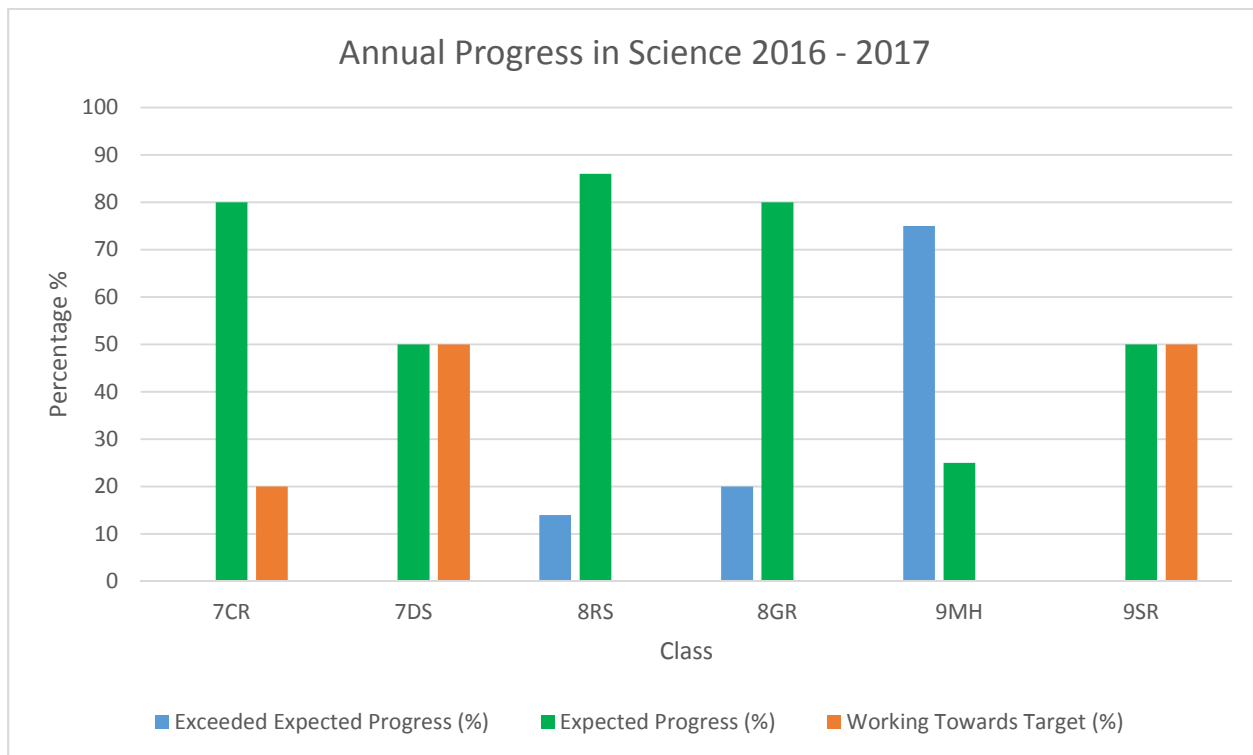
Key Stage 3 Maths (Years 7, 8 and 9) Progress by Year Group



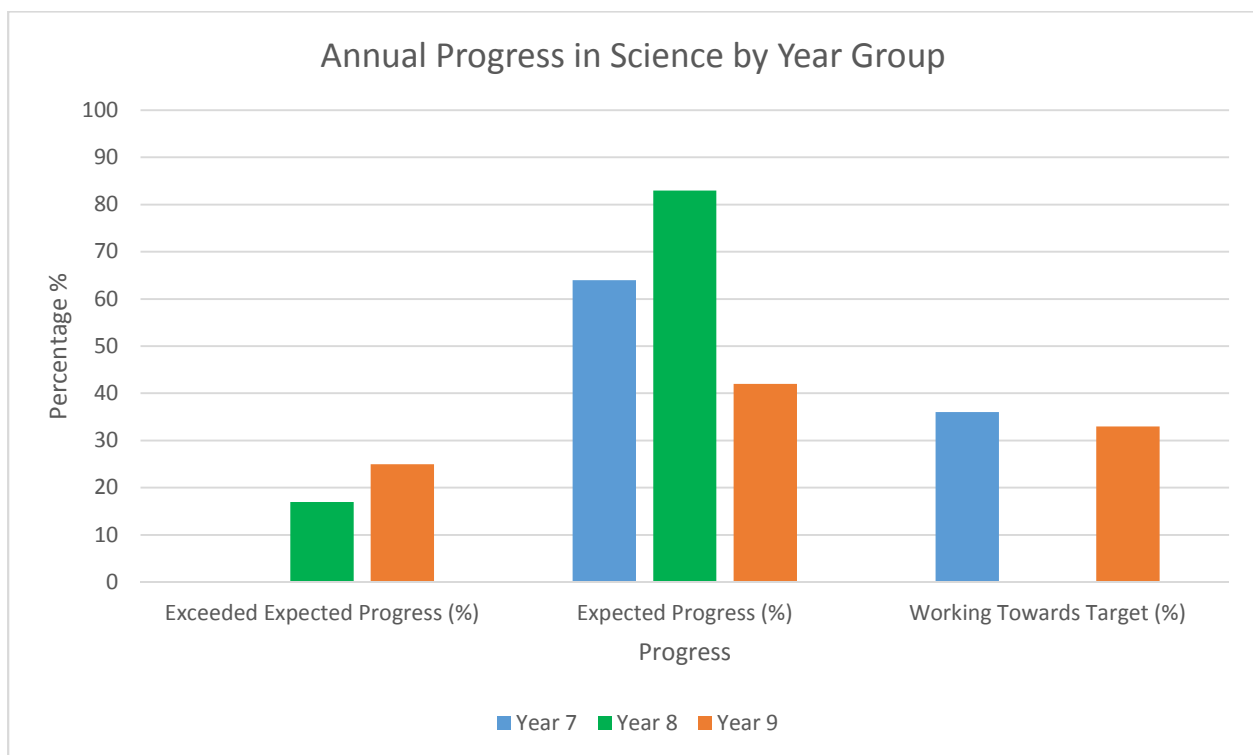
Data Headlines

Key Stage 3 Science (Years 7, 8 and 9) Progress by Year Group



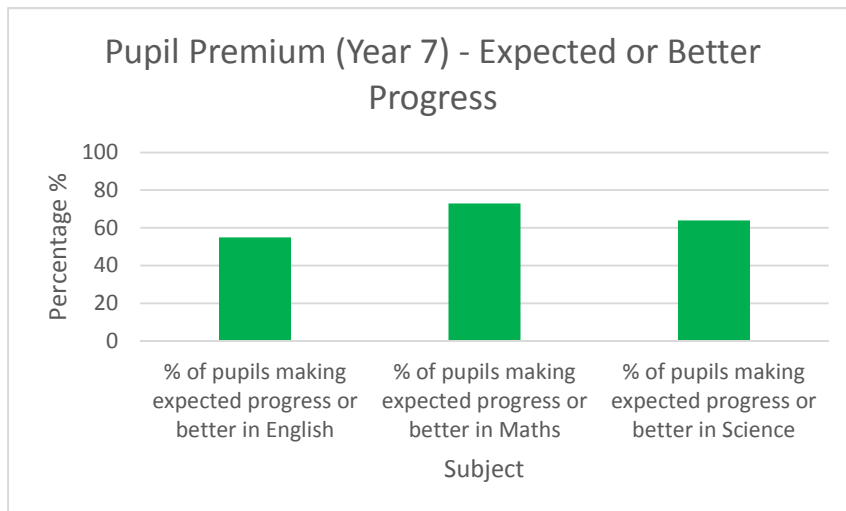
Data Headlines

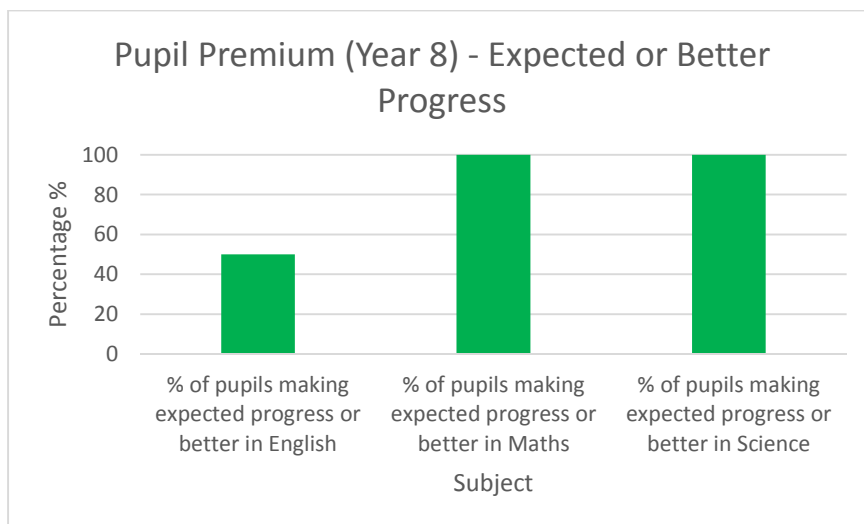

- 73% of pupils who we receive the pupil premium for made expected progress or better in Maths.

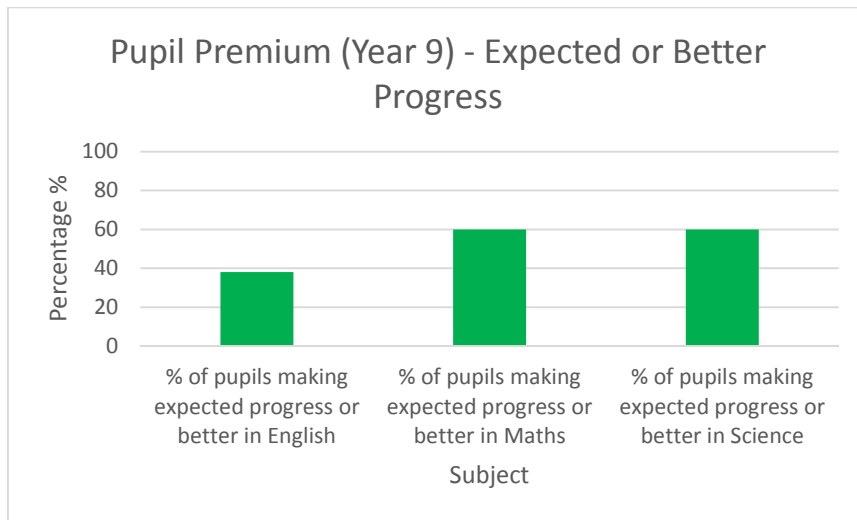
Year 8

Year 9

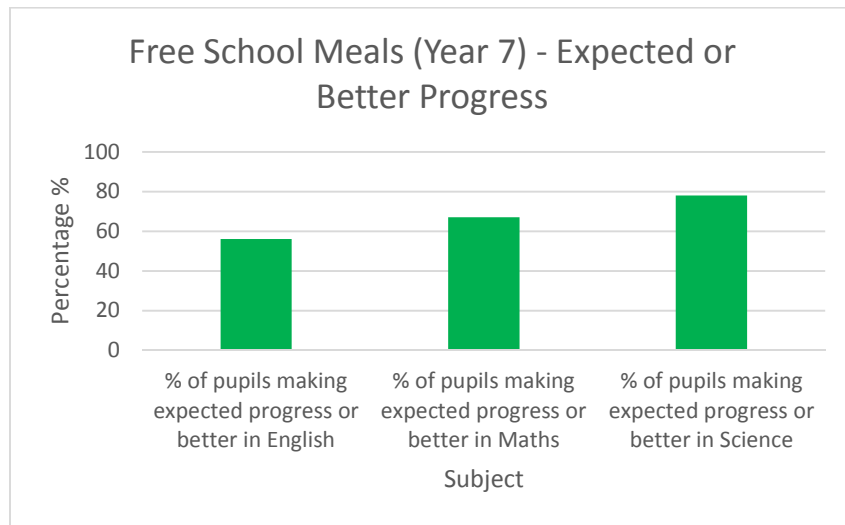


Data Headlines

Free School Meals Analysis

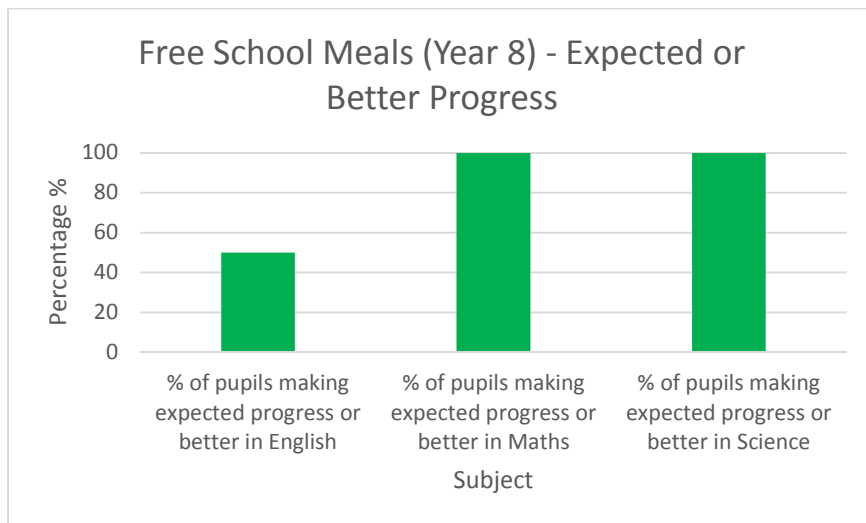
Year 7

- 78% of pupils in receipt of a free school meal made expected progress or better in Science.

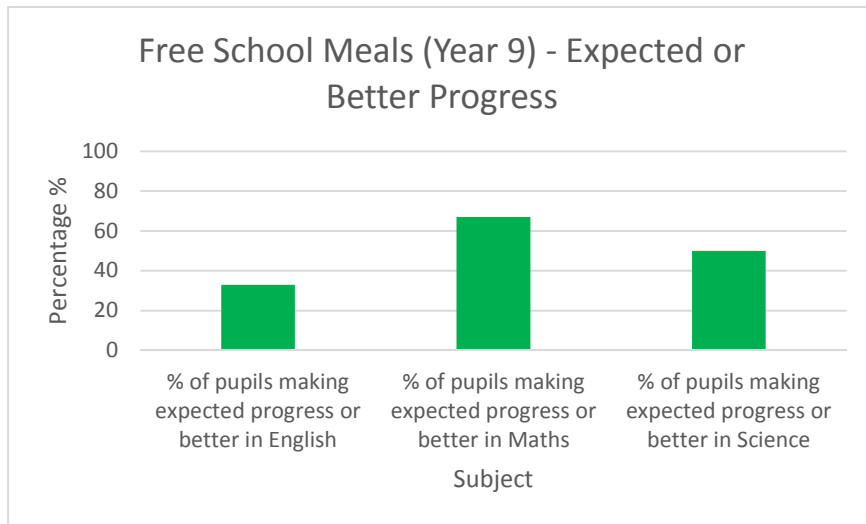
Year 8

Year 9

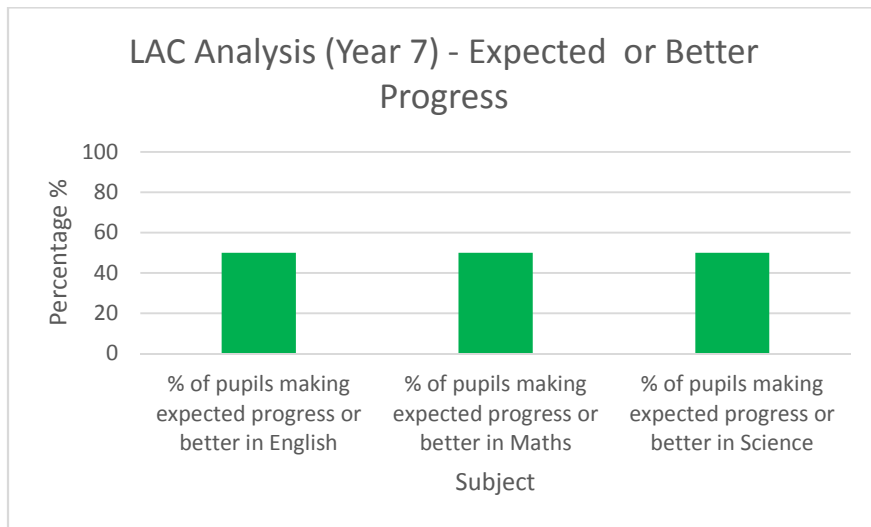


Data Headline

Looked After and Care Analysis

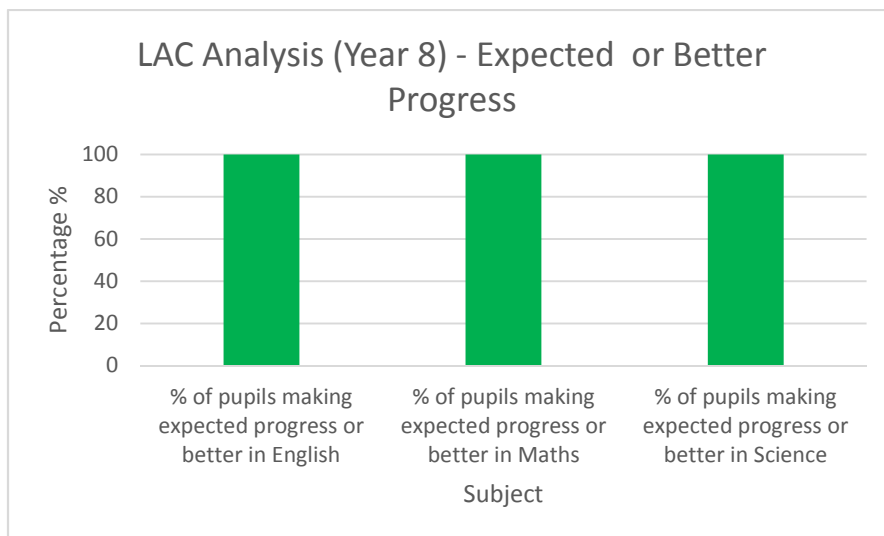
Year 7

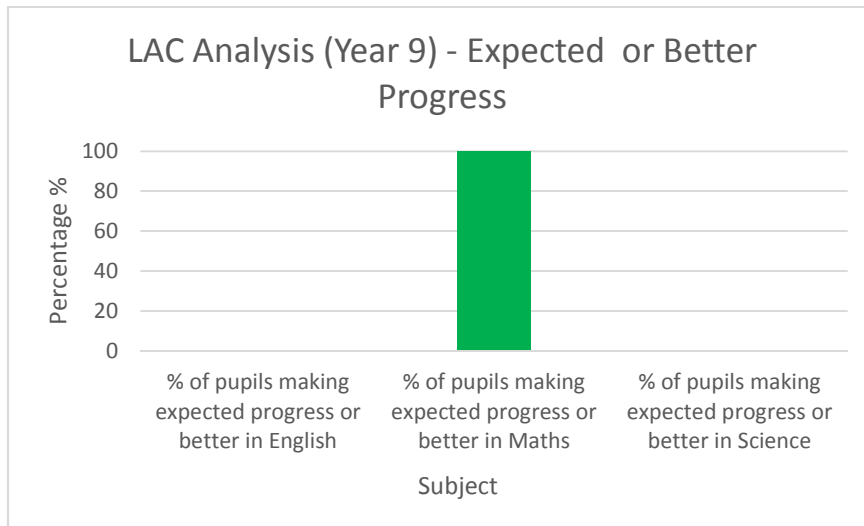
Year 8
